

PROFICIENCY IN LANGUAGE ARTS

Assessments and Evaluations only show a snapshot of student performance. Students at Notre Ecole are assessed with a French language proficiency rubric that examines the four domains of listening, speaking, reading, and writing. The overall percentage of students reaching proficient are detailed below. These results are not end of the year results but through to January 2022.

PROFICIENCY IN MATH

Students at Notre Ecole are assessed in French with a Standards and Benchmarks rubric that examines the four domains of Counting and Cardinality, Operations and Algebraic Thinking, Measurement and Data, and Geometry. The overall percentage of students reaching proficient are detailed below. These results are not end of the year results but through to June 2022.

Kindergarten Proficiency

Counting and Cardinality 82% Oper. and Alg. Thinking 82% Measurement and Data 88% Geometry 88% Overall Math Proficiency 85%

1st grade Proficiency

Counting and Cardinality 91% Oper. And Alg. Thinking 75% Measurment and Data 83% Geometry 75 % Overall Math Proficiency 81%

2nd grade Proficiency

Counting and Cardinality 96% Oper. And Alg. Thinking 91% Measurment and Data 87% Geometry 93% Overall Math Proficiency 92%

ATTENDANCE DATA

Chronic absence directly relates to a student's level of success, as it contributes to the proliferation of the achievement gap. Children who are chonically absent in Kindergarten and 1st grade are far less likely to read proficiently at the end of 3rd grade.

If children don't show up for school regularily, they miss out on fundamental reading and math skills and the chance to build a habit of good attendance that will carry them in to college and careeers.

Analyzing attendance data across time is one way to track attendance trends.

SUSPENSION DATA

Students school years are filled with ways to grow and achieve academically and socially. Our Multi-Tiered System of Support has key behavioral supports for teachers, including Restoritive Practices and Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports. These strategies help to increase instructional time, improve student social behavior and academic outcomes, and decrease disruptions.

Analyzing out-of-school suspensions across time is one way to track disciplinary trends. Suspension rate is defined as the number of students who have received one or more suspensions divided by the number of students enrolled at any time during the school year.

PARENT TEACHER CONFERENCE DATA

The more involved parents are in their child's education, the more likely the child is to succeed in school. Research shows that parent support is important to a child's success at school.

Analyzing parent teacher conference attendance data across time is one way to track communication and parent involvment trends as it relates to student success.


NOTRE ECOLE SUSPENSION RATE
